

For Frisco College-Bound Graduating Seniors, Spring 2023

Title: 2023 Frisco Garden Club \$3,000 College Scholarship.

The Frisco Garden Club (FGC) is the oldest active civic organization in the City of Frisco. Founded in 1932, FGC partners closely with the Frisco Parks and Rec Department to sustain beautification projects around the City. FGC also promotes plant, gardening and nature knowledge through monthly meetings and special events such as Arbor Day. FGC has long provided scholarships to Frisco ISD Students through the Frisco Education Foundation. The success of recent fund-raising events has enabled the Frisco Garden Club to expand its scholarship program this year by offering graduating seniors the opportunity to apply for a \$3,000 one-time scholarship to private, charter, and home school students residing within the city limits of Frisco. Once selected, the recipient will be presented with their award at the June 6th Frisco City Council meeting during National Garden Week, celebrated June 4-10 this year.

Qualifications: Must be a graduating senior planning a major in horticulture, botany, landscape design, floriculture, forestry, agronomy, environmental or climate science, and a resident of Frisco. Additional considerations include:

- Involvement in school and the Frisco community, particularly if they are/were FGC members and/or worked on one of the FGC gardens as a volunteer.
- Demonstrated character and leadership ability.
- Academic record.
- A short essay on the applicant's involvement in gardening and horticulture, and their goals and aspirations for the future.

Deadline: April 28th. Notification of award to recipient by May 22.
